

Regulations on the Organization of the Energy Management Committee at National Chung Cheng University

Approved on November 28, 2005, during the 306th Administrative Meeting.
Amended and approved on May 24, 2010, during the 356th Administrative Meeting.

Article 1: Basis for Formulation

These regulations are established based on the Energy Management Act and its implementation rules.

Article 2: Purpose of Energy Management

The purpose of these regulations is to actively promote energy-saving efforts, enhance the University's energy management, identify deficiencies in current energy usage, seek feasible improvement solutions, and ensure rational and effective use of energy. This aims to reduce energy costs, improve competitiveness, and achieve energy-saving goals.

Article 3: Types and Scope of Energy

1. Electricity.
2. Water.
3. Oil.

Article 4: Organization of the Committee

The organization of the Energy Management Committee is as follows:

1. **Chairperson:** The Vice President serves as the Chairperson.
2. **Vice Chairperson:** The Director of General Affairs serves as the Vice Chairperson.
3. **Members:** Include the Director of Academic Affairs, Director of Student Affairs, Director of Research and Development, Director of the Computing Center, Director of the Library, Director of the Sports Center, Director of the Environmental Safety Center, and Deans of various colleges. Additionally, experts and scholars with relevant expertise may be appointed as needed.
4. The Committee will have an Executive Secretary, who is the Head of the Construction and Maintenance Division, responsible for assisting the Chairperson with execution, coordination of relevant matters, and convening Committee meetings. Additionally, several Energy Managers will be appointed from personnel handling relevant tasks in the Construction and Maintenance Division.

Article 5: Responsibilities of the Committee

1. Establish energy auditing systems.
2. Set energy-saving goals and implementation plans.
3. Develop energy-saving methods.

4. Establish energy-saving standards and benchmarks.
5. Create and distribute energy-saving promotional materials.

Article 6: Meetings

The Committee shall hold a meeting once a year before January 15. Extraordinary meetings may be convened as necessary. The Committee may invite relevant units to attend meetings as needed.

Article 7: Miscellaneous

Matters not covered in these regulations shall be handled in accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

Article 8: Implementation and Amendments

These regulations shall be implemented after approval by the Administrative Meeting and final approval by the President. The same procedure applies to amendments.
